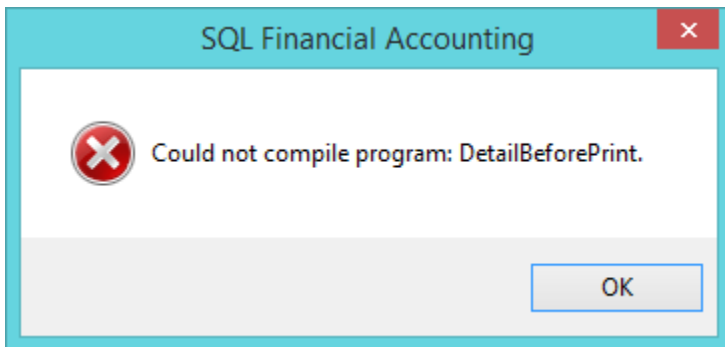
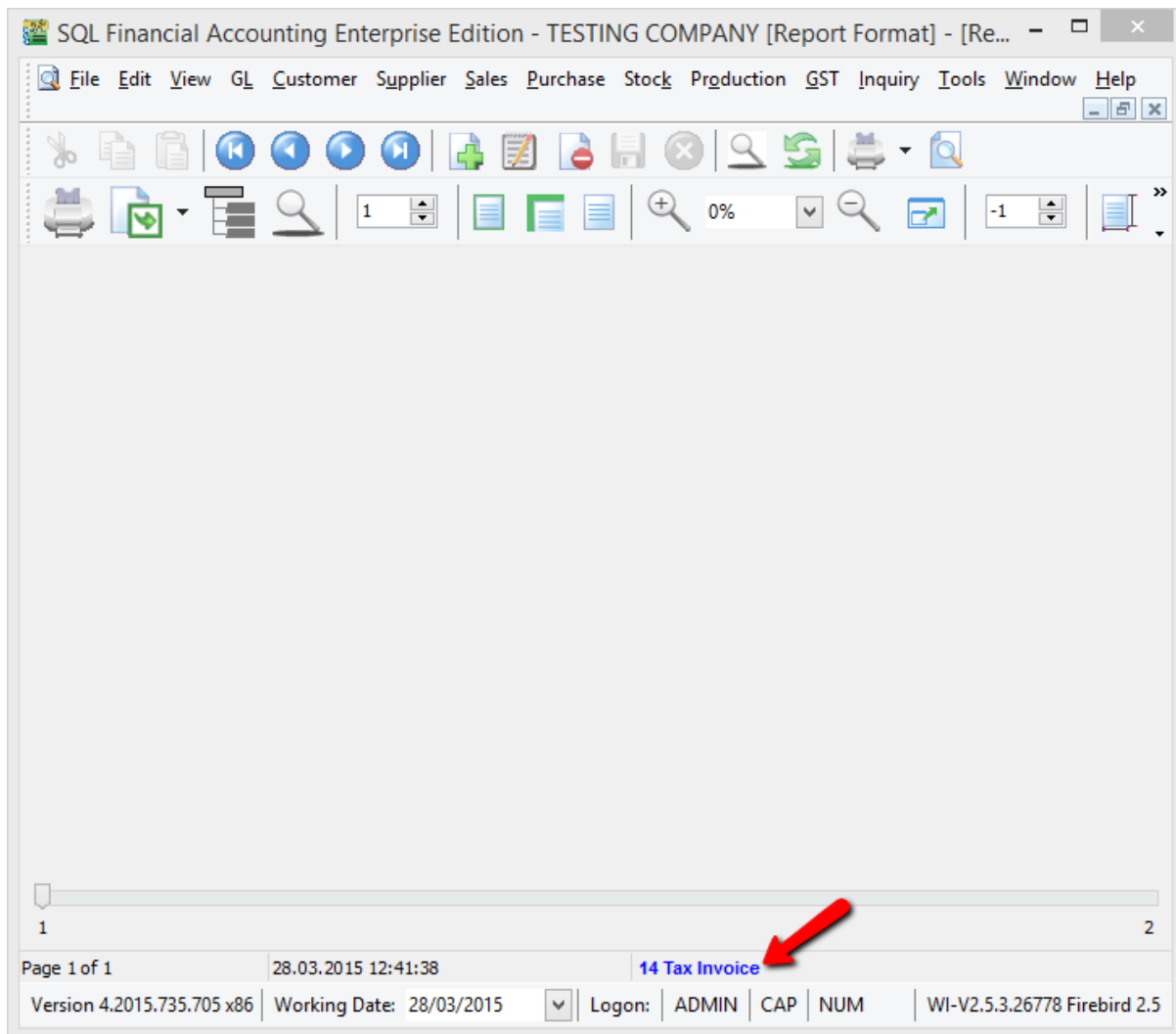


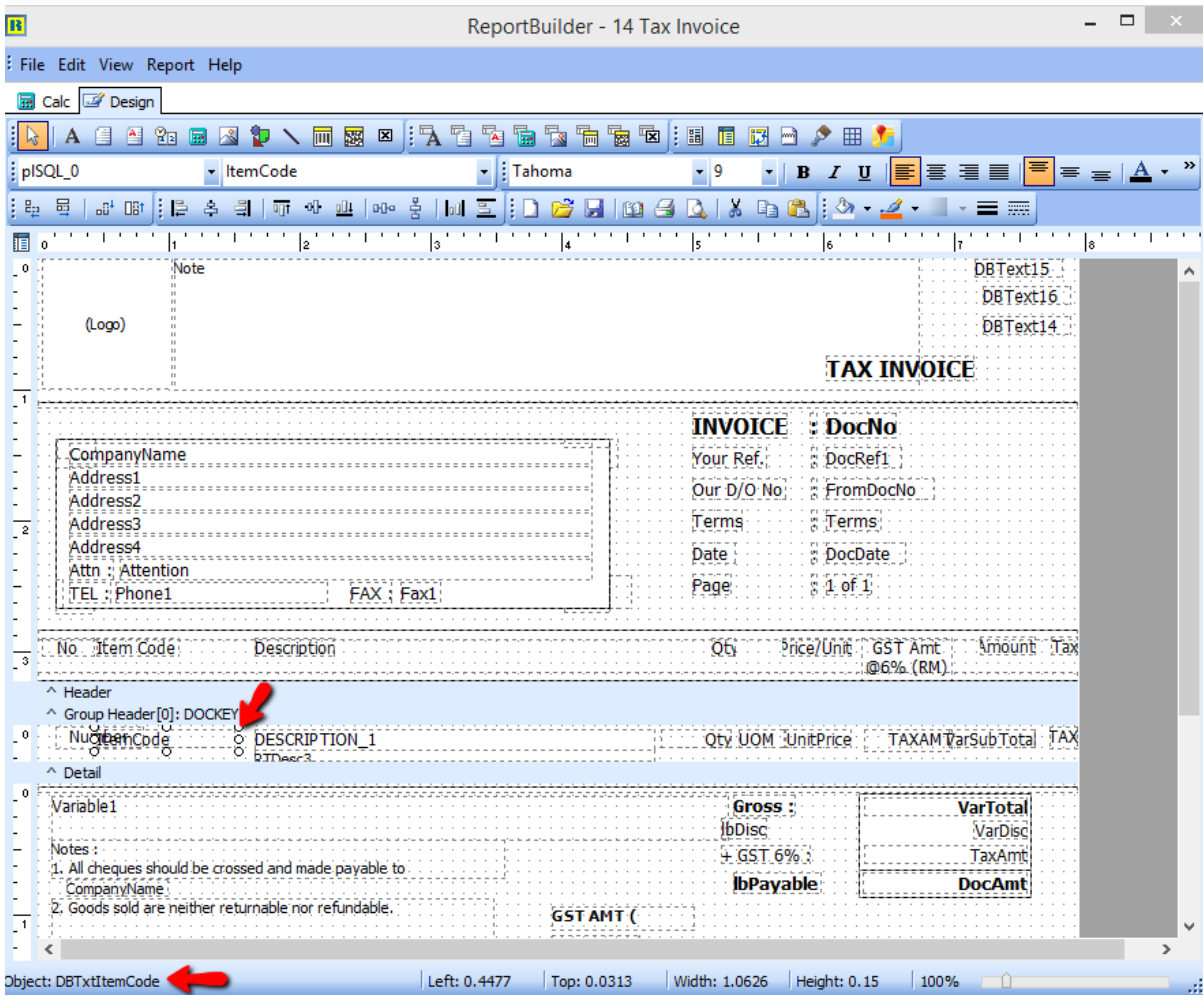
# How to disable query for deleted field in report designer



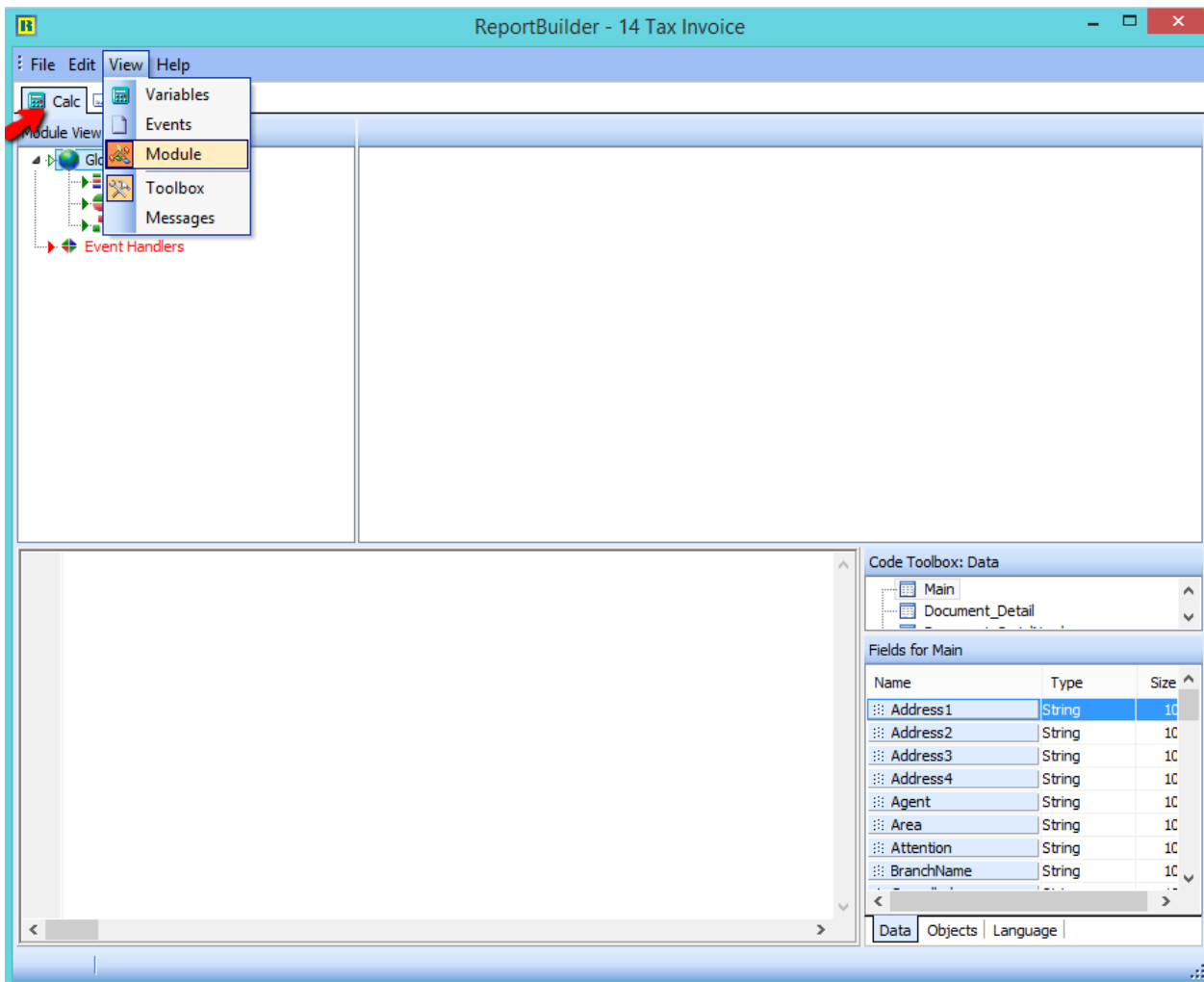
1) If you had deleted any field in report designer with Query, then u will get above message, click Ok

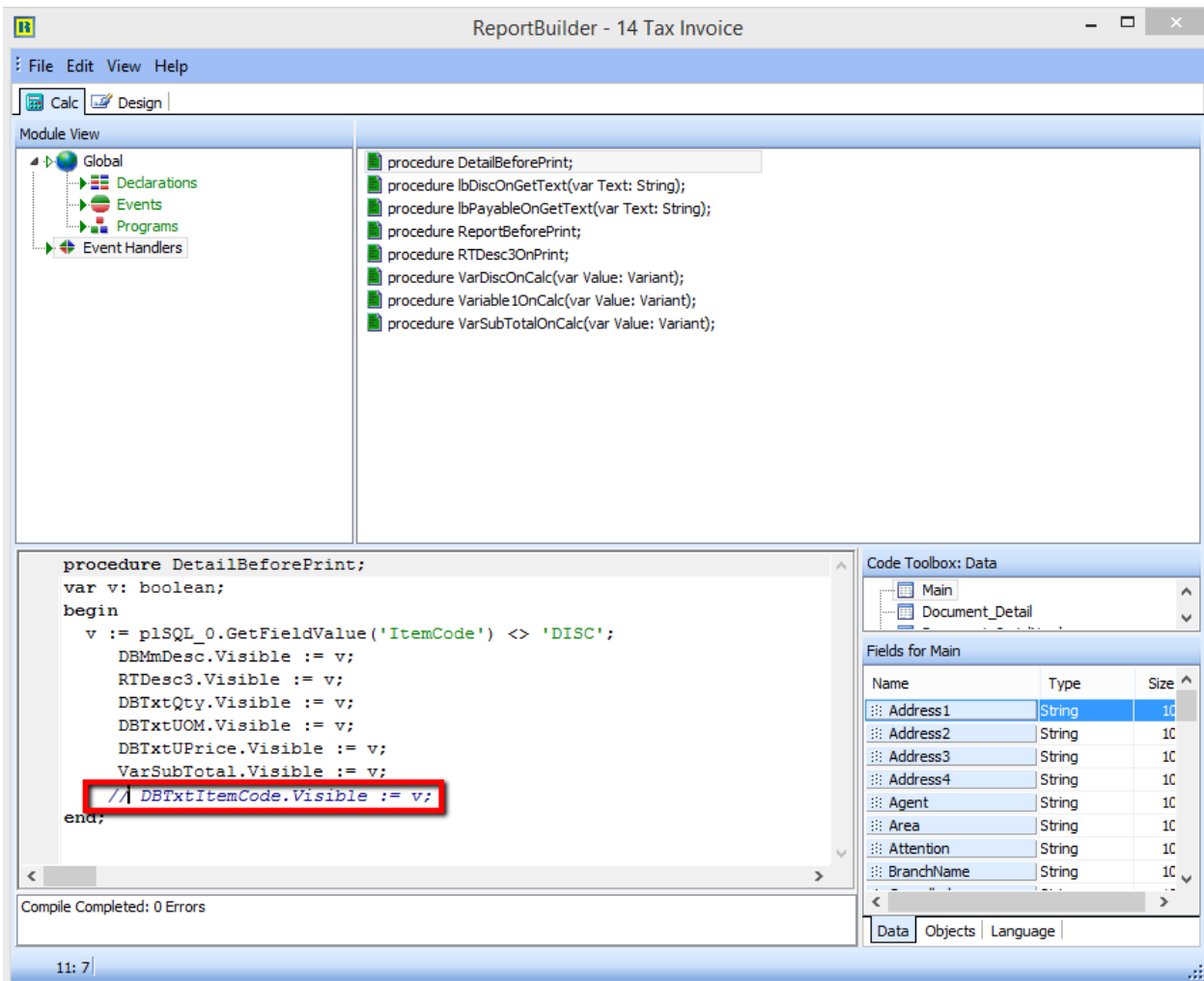

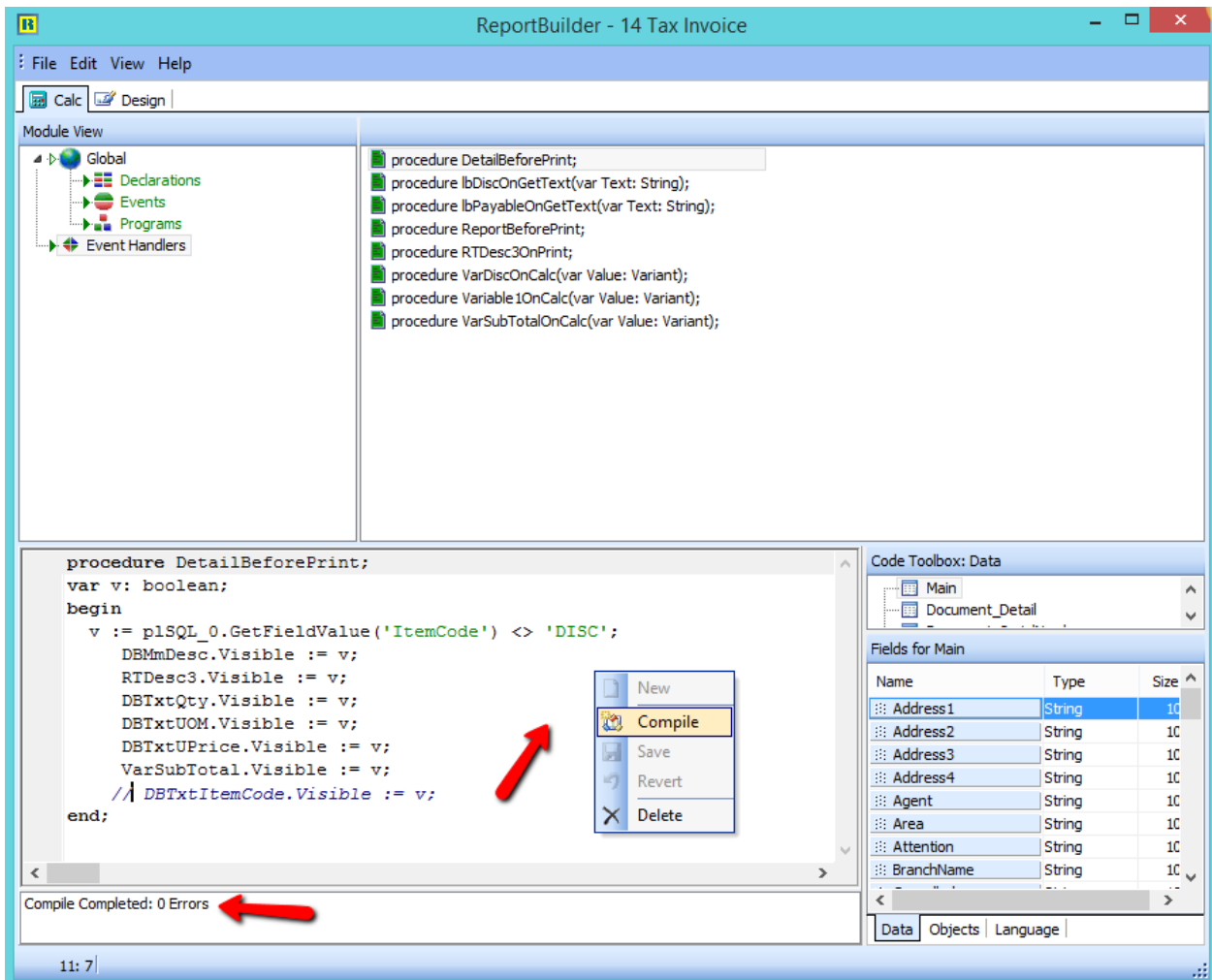
5) Click on Event Handlers
